## VEGGIES

### NEW this year

All tomatoes, eggplant, peppers, ground cherries, tomatillos, cucumbers, melons and all members of the squash family are available in organic plantable 4.5” pots. This means less transplant shock for the plants AND less plastic to be recycled!

Unfortunately, this particular type of plantable containers are not yet available in smaller sizes or in the 4-packs and 6-packs. These are still in plastic. Until then, returning your empty plastic containers enables us to keep prices lower. We will clean and reuse the following year.

Individual plants in pots or packs — fully hardened off and ready to plant in your garden.

When the plants are well established, mulch to retain water if needed, retard weeds and keep leaves clean. Fertilize with a good organic fertilizer. Drip irrigation or soaker hoses help to keep the foliage dry.

Mix of: Astro (mildly spicy), Esmee (more nutty), Rocket (robust peppery) and Ice-bred (complex full flavors). Mix of strap and cut leaf shapes as young plants. Good as a cut and come again crop. Cook mature leaves with other greens. Protect from heat with shade cloth to retard bolting.

Heat tolerant broccoli for spring, summer and fall crops. Compact plants have round domes, small to medium beads and short stems with a thick main stalk. Domes span 6-8" at maturity and average 1.5 lbs. Ideal for short-stemmed crown cuts or florets. 10-14 day harvest window.

Stressful field conditions don't bother this workhorse broccoli - upright, large-framed plants produce big, tightly beaded heads for reliable harvests. Good for both spring and fall production. 6-8" heads.

Released in 1986 by Dr Munger of Cornell, this white-spined slicer is 5 days earlier, dark green skin and a slimmer shape. This along with broader disease resistance, a less sprawling keafy habit and high yields gives us a noteworthy alternative to Marketmore 76.

60 Days

A slender Asian burpless variety with delicate skin and sweet flavor. Vigorous plants produce long, slim fruits with higher yields and smoother skin than the heirloom Suyu Long. An early producer, Tasty Green F1 offers high quality fruit with shallow ridges and crisp texture. Popular for growing in home gardens. Best quality trellised, as fruits tend to curl if plants are left to grow over the ground. Intermediate resistance to downy mildew.

Open-pollinated. Beth Rasgorshek of Canyon Bounty in Idaho crossed King Richard with Siegfried Frost leek to create a versatile stable cultivar that has some of the good attributes of both. Sieg appears to have inherited the most from Siegfried. Its shafts are intermediate between the long King Richard and the short Siegfried, about 6" long but with a wonderful 3" thickness for a wide edible area. It also has some of Siegfried's delightful blue-green coloration and delayed maturity.

Oblong, sweet, orange-fleshed fruits have light netting and weigh 2-3 pounds. Fruits keep 1-2 days after slipping. 65-80 days

## Emerald Gem Melons

80 Days

"Luscious beyond description" was W. Atlee Burpee's review from 1886. Sweet and juicy orange flesh with a rich, musky flavor and spicy cinnamon aroma that is prized to this day. A heavy producer with dark green, slightly netted skin. Short harvest window; collect melons when skin becomes netted and fruits slip from the vine. Also known as 'Netted Gem'.

An attractive red Cipollini-type with excellent flavor. Slightly slower to mature than yellow varieties, but with comparable shape and size. Excellent flavor for eating raw or cooking.

### Corno di Toro Frying Peppers

70 Days Sweet

Large, highly attractive scarlet, tapering 6-8" fruits are long and narrow, often with the bull horn curve for which they are named. Quickly turns gold and then a beautiful deep crimson color with sweet, full-bodied flavor when fully ripe. Versatile and great for eating raw, stuffed, grilled or traditionally fried in olive oil and sprinkled with parmesan. Plants are vigorous with an excellent upright habit. Personally, I love these peppers for their size, flavor and the thickness of the chili pepper walls. They are ideal for roasting and the thickness makes them slightly meaty.

Small, mild Japanese pepper for roasting, pan-frying and grilling. Thin walls blister and char easily when roasted or grilled, taking on rich flavor that is delicious with coarse salt and lemon juice. Pepper lore has it that the occasional fruit will display heat. Typically harvested and used green, but eventually turns orange and red with sweeter flavor. Prolific! Spreading habit

Jamaican Hot Red is a very compact plant with an abundance of thin skin hot peppers. Shaped like a lantern. Very tasty with lots of flavor even though it is hot. 100,000-200,000 on the Scoville scale.

85 Days Heat Level 0

This wonderful seasoning pepper from Trinidad may look like a typical habanero, but it has no heat. What it does have is delectable pepper flavor that adds so much to make Caribbean dishes or other cuisines really special. Pendant peppers are 1 to 1 1/2 inches long and mature to golden orange-yellow. Plants are tall and extremely prolific.

They offer wonderful fruity taste but only mild to medium heat despite being related to the more fiery habanero. Peppers may be harvested green or left to ripen fully red. Originally from Peru.

Mild heart-shaped chili perfect for stuffing in chiles rellenos or dried for ancho chili powder. Stout dark green fruits are moderately spicy with medium-thick walls. Referred to as Poblano when used fresh and Ancho when dried for seasoning. Plants are well branched. Well adapted variety; good yields in cool conditions.

Open-pollinated. Fruits so striking that many keep a bowl on the table just to admire. Black when immature, the 2 1/2"-long conical peppers ripen to lustrous garnet. Mild juicy thick-walled flesh runs with a cherry-red juice when cut. The heat, a tad less than a jalapeño, is in the ribs and seeds and is "just right for many of us," says one customer. Why not try candied sliced Czech Blacks like citrus peel for a spicy-sweet holiday treat. Bears very early with 20 pointed thick-walled peppers per 2 1/2-3' plant.

Open-pollinated. A product of our inventory manager Roberta Bailey's many years of dedicated breeding work to create an open-pollinated selection of the hybrid Super Chili, whose parents include Hungarian Hot Wax and Hot Banana. The squat plants bear prolific upright fruit, averaging 2" long, 1/3" across and ripening from pale green to deep scarlet. Like Super Chili, they bear well in cold damp weather, hot dry weather, sandy soils and heavy clay. They have plenty of heat and the characteristic finely cut lightweight leaves of many hot peppers. Can be potted and overwintered or brought inside to make a beautiful pepper wreath when frost threatens. 30,000-50,000 Scoville units. OSSI. 2000 Fedco introduction.

The largest of New Mexican varieties, this pepper has pods up to 12 inches long that weigh as much as 4 ounces. Their size makes them a favorite for chiles rellenos. Medium hot pungency. As an advantage, plants are able to set fruit under hot, dry conditions.

Long, banana-shaped waxy pepper used for frying, stuffing and pickling. Ripens from pale yellow to deep golden orange and finally cherry red, but traditionally harvested light green and used for pickling. May be harvested at any stage but heat intensifies as peppers mature. Very productive even in cool weather. Heat varies among strains; HMOS strain is spicy

110 Days Heat Level 4

Ghost Pepper / Bhut Jolokia is one of the hottest peppers in the world with 350,000-1,000,000 Scoville units. The peppers are 2 1/2 - 3" long and are green ripening to red. They have a long, narrow shape and a complex taste. The plants are very slow growing when young.

## Early Jalapeno Hot Peppers

65 Days Heat Level 2

Prolific yields of flavorful blunt fruits with distinctive jalapeno flavor. Small, moderately spicy fruits with thick walls are traditionally harvested dark green but can be allowed to ripen to red. A classic eaten fresh or pickled with Mexican dishes! Compact plants are sturdy and work well in containers.

## NuMex Suave Orange Hot Peppers

95 Days Heat Level 0

Developed by the Chile Pepper Institute, this pepper has all the wonderful flavor of a habanero but with very little heat, only about 800 Scoville Units. The distinctive habanero citrus-like aroma and flavor remains and many people can enjoy it better without the searing heat of a regular habanero. The word "suave" means smooth or mild in Spanish, and that is descriptive of the mellow flavor this variety delivers. Tall plants typically produce about 100 peppers each..


